



Search term = educational leadership




Proquest Education Database:

Subject term = learning styles


Use email, print, cite, save options to keep track of your research



JSTOR Database:



Use Advanced Search and scroll down to expand/select Education journal titles

Print Resources:

When searching for a print resource in the library, you can use a title, keyword, or Library of Congress Classification Number to search the catalog. Call numbers help you find the exact location of an item and to find more items that have similar content.
